Transfer Credit Requirements

Evaluation of Transfer Credit

The University has evaluated the content and competencies of the Project Management Professional (PMP). Students and prospective students must submit required documentation for evaluation prior to completion the PM courses listed in the crosswalk below to:

Required documentation includes one of the following:

- <u>Certificate of Completion</u>: Student name, date of completion, and training provider information (seal, logo, signature, web URL, etc.).
 NOTE: PMP certificate must be current and not expired.
- <u>License</u>: Student name, date of completion, training provider information (seal, logo, signature, web URL, etc.).
- <u>Transcript:</u> Student name, the title of course(s), date(s) of completion, amount of time taken to complete the course(s), and training provider information (seal, logo, signature, web URL, etc.).
- <u>Copy of Exam Report:</u> Student name, date of completion, training provider information (seal, logo, signature, website URL, etc.).
